Amazon Pharmacy will replace CVS Caremark Mail Service Pharmacy as our prescription home delivery pharmacy effective January 1, 2025.

Eligibility

If a member has a maintenance prescription with CVS Caremark Mail Service Pharmacy, it can easily be transfer to Amazon Pharmacy through what is known ORTF (open refill transfer file).

- Member must set up account and request their prescriber to send the prescription to Amazon Pharmacy.
- 2. Amazon Pharmacy does not service class 2 drugs (ADHD, Pain Medication.)
- If the medication is a class 2 drug- the CVS mail order must transition to a retail pharmacy.
- 4. Members utilizing class 3,4, or 5 drugs must obtain a new prescription from their prescriber before transitioning to Amazon Pharmacy.

Member with an ORTF (open refill transfer) and non-class II should set an account with amazon pharmacy via the direct link provided in the Amazon flyer.

Member with a non-ORTF (open refill transfer) should request a new prescription from the prescriber to be send to Amazon Pharmacy, and then set up an account via the direct link provided in the Amazon flyer.

Member with a class II non ORTF, should request a new prescription from the prescriber, and find a new retail pharmacy to fill the prescription.
