

Amazon Pharmacy will replace CVS Caremark Mail Service Pharmacy as our prescription home delivery pharmacy effective January 1, 2025.

<p>If a member has a maintenance prescription with CVS Caremark Mail Service Pharmacy, it can easily be transfer to Amazon Pharmacy through what is known ORTF (open refill transfer file).</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Member must set up account and request their prescriber to send the prescription to Amazon Pharmacy. 2. Amazon Pharmacy does not service class 2 drugs (ADHD, Pain Medication.) 3. If the medication is a class 2 drug- the CVS mail order must transition to a retail pharmacy. 4.
